- All products **must be** processed according to recognized safe methods found in the most recent editions of the **Ball Blue Book or the USDA Complete Guide to Home Canning. Inverted jams and jellies will not be judged.**
- All jars must be labeled as to content, processing method (pressure canner or boiling water bath) and processing time. ADJUST PROCESSING TIMES FOR ALTITUDE. See label example below.
- 5-8 year olds may enter contests for exhibit only. Participation ribbons will be awarded but no premiums. In compliance with North Carolina 4-H competition policy, participants ages 5-8 are not eligible to compete for award premiums.
