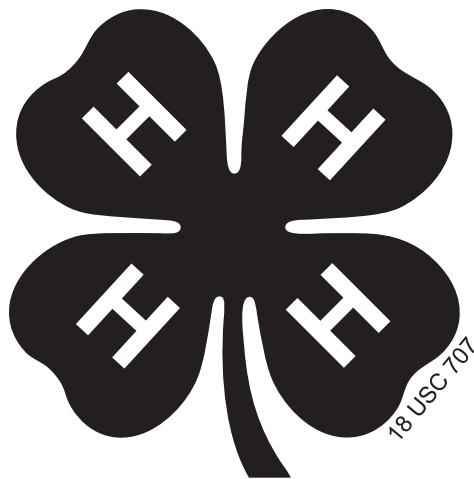

General Rules and Regulations

The Madison County Fair follows the rules and regulations set forth by the North Carolina 4-H and Youth Development Program. Only youth ages 9-18 (as of January 1, 2017) are eligible to compete in Madison County 4-H Open Livestock Shows. Exhibitors ages 9-18 must show his/her own livestock without assistance. Youth ages 5-8 (as of January 1, 2017) may participate but the exhibitor's animals will not be judged competitively. Exhibitors ages 5-8 may be assisted by an adult. **Youth do not have to be a Madison County 4-H member to participate in 4-H Livestock Shows.**

Exhibitors must have "cared for" all animals at least 30 days prior to the date of the show.

Exhibitors must provide food and water for their animal exhibits (except poultry) and keep their animals and area clean and presentable at all times.

Animals will be released after the completion of each show. There will be no removal of animals while the shows are in progress. Poultry exhibits must remain in place the duration of the fair.

Any exhibitor removing animals without official release or before release time will forfeit any prize monies and/or awards.

The Agricultural Livestock Committee will rule on all matters not covered by these or other department rules. The judge's decisions are final.

Completed entry forms and applicable forms must be **RECEIVED** by Friday, September 21, 2018. All requested information must be completed for an entry form to be considered official. Entries will be received until the entry deadline. **Mail entries to: Madison County Fair, c/o Madison County Extension Center, 258 Carolina Lane, Marshall, NC 28753. No checks accepted for entry fees after September 17,**

Any exhibitor using abusive or excessive force with their animal as determined by the on-site 4-H Livestock Committee members will be asked to leave the fairground and forfeit any premium money or awards.

Livestock bedding must be provided and cleaned up by exhibitors (shavings, please). Provisions will be made for the disposal of animal waste, litter and trash.

Rules and Regulations

- Any youth is eligible to exhibit.
- Youth under the age of 19 as of January 1, 2018 are eligible to participate. Youth ages 14 and older as of January 1 will be considered Senior exhibitors and youth ages 9-13 as of January 1 will be considered Junior exhibitors. Youth ages 5-8 as of January 1 will show in noncompetitive classes only. A ribbon will be awarded to teach exhibitor in these noncompetitive classes. Youth under the age of 5 are not eligible to participate.
- Birds will be entered in single classes only.
- All birds will be cared for and fed by the fair.
- The fair will furnish cages and cups for food and water.
- All birds must be entered in the name of the bona fide owner who must have owned the birds for at least 30 days prior to deadline.
- All birds are entered at the risk of the owner and the Madison County Fair will not be responsible for any loss or damage but will exercise all possible vigilance in the care of the birds. No one will be allowed to handle birds on display except the owners and officials of the show.
- The American Standard of Perfection will be the guide used in awarding premiums.
- Judge will not award premiums to any animal because of its mere presence. It must be individually worthy. The judge has the right not to award a first place ribbon/premium if the item does not merit the placing.
- Decision of the judge will be final.
- Exhibitors may not accompany judge during his/her deliberations.
- Birds must remain on exhibition for the duration of the fair.

- YK02 Cockerel: Male bird, less than 1 year old
- YK03 Hen: Female bird, 1 year old or over
- YK04 Pullet: Female bird, less than 1 year old
- YK05 Tom: Male Turkey
- YK06 Turkey Hen: Female Turkey

Best of Show:

- Standard Chicken
- Bantam Chicken

Health Requirements: Birds will be blood typed by NCDA Veterinary Division on site.

Rules and Regulations

- Any youth is eligible to exhibit.
- Youth under the age of 19 as of January 1, 2018 are eligible to participate. Youth ages 14 and older as of January 1 will be considered Senior exhibitors and youth ages 9-13 as of January 1 will be considered Junior exhibitors. Youth ages 5-8 as of January 1 will show in noncompetitive classes only. A ribbon will be awarded to each exhibitor in these noncompetitive classes. Youth under the age of 5 are not eligible to participate.
- Participants exhibit animals at their own risk. No health papers are required. However, NCDA Veterinary Division Veterinarian may be on site to inspect your animal.
- All animals must be shown at halter.
- If an exhibitor has more than one animal in a class, the second entry may be shown by another eligible youth.
- Each exhibitor must assume all liability in the case of death or injury to his/her livestock.
- In any case where questions arise that are not covered specifically by these rules, the decision of the Madison County Fair Show Rules Committee will be final.
- Exhibitors must have been the primary caretakers of the heifer(s) entered in his/her name for at least 30 Days prior to the show date.
